

WHO QUALIFIES FOR NSFAS?

- 1. Student must be a South African citizen
- 2. Must be registering for the first time for an undergraduate qualification
- 3. Must be admitted to study in a university or TVET college
- 4. Combined household annual income must not exceed R350 000 per annum.

Students who are South African citizens, including those with disability, who have applied and accepted to study at an accredited funded university or TVET. Undergraduate students studying for their first higher education qualification

Students must meet the academic performance requirement and prove that they are financially needy.

Students seeking NSFAS support must have an annual household income not exceeding R350 000 00.
